Interpretative Trail Project

Hawthorn Hollow Nature Sanctuary and Arboretum is proud to announce that it has once again received a grant from the 2021 Creativity by Kids (CBK) Small Grant Program, a branch of the Kenosha Community Foundation. The grant was awarded to create a new interpretive trail cultural. historical. featuring environmental landmarks, as well as a new nature scavenger hunt program. This is the second CBK Small Grant awarded to Hawthorn Hollow, after last year's grant to create the Mother Nature and Me program. The CBK Small Grant

Program is funded by the Clark-Barber Family Fund and the Kubasiewicz Family Trust, and specifically awards funds to groups offering programs in the arts or that focus on our understanding of the natural world.

Mother Nature & Me

This Spring and Summer, Hawthorn Hollow will be putting on the "Mother Nature and Me" series, a collection of environmental education programs that are designed to foster connections to nature through play, art, science and literacy. This program was made possible by our 2020 CBK grant from the Kenosha Community Foundation, but the series was postponed due to COVID. The program is designed for young children and an adult caregiver to learn together through a shared experience. Topics for these programs will include

water, mud, sticks, wildlife, flowers, trees and others. An art activity will be included in all programs, such as mud & water color painting, nature collage, leaf rubbings, mud sculptures, and more.

2021 Observatory Weekly Series

Beneath the Cosmos

This event offers a relaxing tour of the night sky with the use of our zero-gravity chairs. We use a laser pointer to identify stars, planets, galaxies, constellations, and other objects of interest while explaining their relationships and significance.

Through the Lens

Take turns looking through our telescope at binary stars, dim planets, galaxies, and other sky objects. Between individual views in the observatory, receive a guided sky tour outside under the stars to get the big picture of what you see in the telescope.

Wine Wednesdays

Relax in a zero-gravity chair with your own wine or beverage you bring while we guide you through the night sky, using our laser pointer to show you stars, planets, constellations, and tell stories of their origins.

No beverages will be for sale at this event.

Small Eyes Under the Skies

Bring the family out to and take a trip through the solar system as we learn about the size and distance of our closest neighbors. Take our interactive trip followed by an adventure through the telescope to view the planets and other amazing objects.




Ravine Project Holds Water

Last November we saw the construction of our Wetland Restoration for Ravine Protection Project completed. We seeded the entire area and waited to see how the project would perform. As you can see, the project is holding water! All of this snowmelt would have rushed to the ravine, aggravating the erosion problem. While water is still making its way to the ravine, it's at a much lower volume and moving slower, which is exactly what we hoped for.

We are also excited to see the fall seeding is now germinating. This growing season we will continue with vegetation establishment. includina tree shrub planting supplemental seeding, as well as our invasive species control efforts for reed canary grass, buckthorn, multiflora rose, autumn olive, and more. We will also begin to install a trail system through the project area, with the goal of opening up the area to the public next year.


